SCN promotes the use of scientific research to develop its knowledge base and clinical techniques. It is also active in the development and promotion of quality standards of professional training and practice.

The mission of SCN's PIAC is aligned with the mission of APA's Board for the Advancement of Psychology in the Public Interest, which encourages the generation and application of psychological knowledge on issues important to human well-being. SCN PIAC works to enhance scientific understanding of and training in culture, class, race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, age, and disability. SCN PIAC supports efforts to improve educational opportunities for all neuropsychologists and promotes the delivery of neuropsychological services that adhere to culturally sensitive models.

CONA Liaison Responsibilities

- This position requires the liaison to commit to approximately three days of travel each Fall and Spring to attend the APA Fall and Spring Consolidated Meetings in Washington, DC. The first meeting would be 3/24/17-3/26/17. Please ensure you are free on these dates if you plan to apply.
- The liaison attends the CONA meetings and gathers information that may be of interest to SCN, as well as shares information with CONA regarding SCN activities.
- The liaison creates and disperses bi-annual reports to the PIAC Chair based on new initiatives, continuing responsibilities, and key issues associated with CONA committee meeting agendas and discussions at the Consolidated Meetings that are of interest or relevance to SCN.
- The term runs from March 2017 through August 2020.
