## **Society for Clinical Neuropsychology (SCN) Mission**

APA's SCN is a scientific and professional organization of psychologists interested in the study of brain-behavior relationships and the application of neuropsychological knowledge to clinical practice. SCN promotes the use of scientific research to develop its knowledge base and clinical techniques. It also is active in the development and promotion of quality standards of professional training and practice.

## **SCN PIAC Mission**

The mission of SCN's PIAC is aligned with the mission of APA's Board for the Advancement of Psychology in the Public Interest, which encourages the generation and application of psychological knowledge on issues important to human well-being. SCN PIAC works to enhance scientific understanding of and training in culture, class, race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, age, and disability. SCN PIAC supports efforts to improve educational opportunities for all neuropsychologists and promotes the delivery of neuropsychological services that adhere to culturally sensitive models.

## **Mission for the Ethics Subcommittee**

The PIAC Ethics Subcommittee serves as a resource concerning ethical issues in clinical neuropsychology. The subcommittee is responsible for 1) providing ethics consultation; 2) offering ethics continuing education, and 3) assembling ethics resources on the SCN website.

## **Ethics Student Representative Responsibilities**

- Provide ad hoc ethics consultation
- Work collaboratively as a committee to offer continuing education opportunities (e.g., at the APA Annual Convention)
- Assemble ethics resources and update them periodically on the SCN website
- Review and comment on documents, policies, and standards associated with APA and other relevant organizations

There is an expectation that the committee member would attend either the APA Annual Convention or the annual International Neuropsychological Society meeting. The two-year appointment runs from August 2019 to August 2021. This position is excellent for a neuropsychology trainee wishing to get more involved in SCN and APA activities.

## **Application Instructions**

Doctoral students are eligible to apply. Interns and postdocs are not eligible. Applications should be received **no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>**. To apply, please email a cover letter - detailing your interest in the position - and your CV to:
